






## **Job Aid: CPLs in ClosingVue™**


The purpose of this document is to show you how to generate and void a Closing Protection Letter (CPL).

## **Generate CPL**

- 1. In a file, under Maintain File, select Title Policy Information
- 2. Click Generate CPL



- 3. Select the desired option in the **Letter Type** dropdown list
- 4. Enter or revise the Closing Date
- 5. Select Mortgage Clause from the dropdown list
- 6. Select the desired **Covered Party Type**
- 7. Click Submit



**NOTE:** A PDF file displays in a separate window for your review, and a copy is added to the **Document Management** area of your file.





8. Click **X** to close the preview window

Additional Options are available based on location, e.g., **Approved Attorney** dropdown for applicable states. **Additional Party** buttons display for Title and Escrow in applicable states. Please note the **Office State** and **License State** will be defaulted for Title and Escrow. Click **Get Parties** and select the Additional Party.
