


Job Aid: eJackets in ClosingVue™

The purpose of this document is to show you how to generate and void eJackets.

Generate an eJacket

In a file, select Title Policy
 Information from the Maintain File menu



NOTE: An area for both the Loan Policy and the Owner Policy displays.

2. Click the toggle for any Policy for which you want to enter a Jacket


NOTE: TBD displays in the **Policy number** field.

- Select the desired option in the Policy Rate Type dropdown list for the Loan
- 4. Select the desired option in the **Jacket type** dropdown list for the Loan

NOTE: Verify the **Policy Rate Type** and **Jacket type** combination.

- Select the desired option in the **Policy**Rate type dropdown list for theOwner
- Select the desired option in the Jacket type dropdown list for the Owner

NOTE: Verify the **Policy Rate Type** and **Jacket type** combination.



- 7. Select any Endorsement you want to add
- 8. Click Generate Jackets

NOTE: The **Loan Number** pulls in from the ClosingVue file.

Enter or edit the **Date of Policy**, if necessary

NOTE: If no date is entered, the **Closing Date** from the file will be used for the **Date of Policy**.

10.Click **Submit**



NOTE: A **PDF** image of the **Document** displays. A copy is also in your ClosingVue file.



Click X to close the **PDF Document**

NOTE: The Policy number displays in the Policy number field, where previously it contained "TBD". The Generate Jackets link now displays as a Void Jackets button.



Void an eJacket

1. Click Void Jackets



- 2. Select the **Jacket** you want to void
- 3. Enter the reason for voiding the eJacket
- 4. Click Submit



NOTE: An **Informational Message** informs you that the **Jackets** have been voided and the **Policy number** appears as **TBD** again.

5. Click X to close the **Informational Message**

NOTE: The ClosingVue file removes the **Jackets** and **Pending Void** displays in **AgentNet**[®].
