



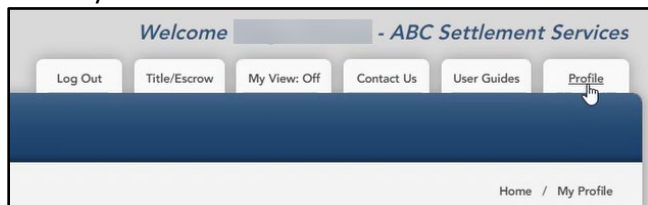
User Authentication Setup – Process in TurboTitle

You can set up your user authentication in TurboTitle.

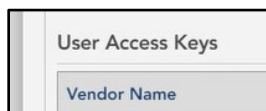
Set Up User Authentication

Secure user authentication eliminates password lockouts and stores your credentials. This process only needs to be performed once per user to set up the integration. This authentication must be set up prior to using the AgentNet integration.

1. Visit the [AgentNet website](#)
2. Log in with your AgentNet credentials
3. Access your Profile



4. Scroll to the **User Access Keys** section

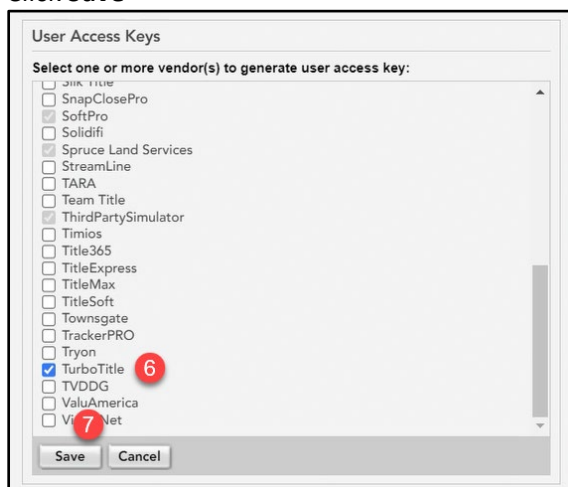


5. Click **Add**



6. Select **TurboTitle**

7. Click **Save**



NOTE: The new User Access Key has a **Status of Created**.



8. Click the copy icon

11. Click the **Turbo Policy** icon
